## What does an EKG technician do?

EKG technicians play a key role in keeping a healthcare facility running smoothly.

Their duties frequently include the following:

- Measure basic vital signs
- Perform rapid response procedures
- Operate an EKG machine and interpret output
- Prepare for, perform, and monitor EKG testing
- Record lead placement, measure and identify rhythms

## Where do they work?

EKG technicians work in round-the-clock healthcare facilities such as hospitals. The 24/7 nature of healthcare makes night and weekend schedules a possibility.\*



### How much do they earn?

With opportunities varying nationwide, EKG technicians can earn competitive salaries. EKG technician salaries vary based on location and experience, but according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the median salary for EKG technicians \$63,020 per year.\* Many techs also qualify for benefits.

## How's the job outlook?

Estimates show that industry employment will remain positive over the next 10 years—up 10% in that time.\*
